

RELISTING POLICY

The purpose of the policy, which applies to all relevant potential signatories, is to provide clarity on relisting. If you have any queries on the policy or process, please contact info@unpri.org.

Signatories leave the PRI for a variety of reasons, and when wishing to rejoin (or “relist”) we apply criteria consistent with a commitment to the Principles, including Principle 6 and the commitment to “report on ... activities and progress towards implementing the Principles.”

There are three scenarios under which former PRI signatories can relist to be a PRI signatory:

1. Former signatories that have voluntarily delisted for any reason, are initially required to provide a ‘senior leadership statement’, evidence of meeting the PRI’s minimum requirements, and commit to reporting in the next available annual cycle, before being allowed to relist.
2. Former signatories that have been delisted by the PRI for failure to report or to meet the minimum requirements must initially complete the annual reporting requirement, including evidence of meeting the minimum requirements, before being allowed to relist.
3. Former signatories that are not required to report, or hold an exemption from reporting, are eligible to relist at any time once they have re-signed their commitment to the Principles.

Every application to become a signatory will be reviewed by the PRI Executive. It is the ultimate decision of the Board to determine signatory status and which signatory category an organisation belongs to, according to the Articles and Signatory Rules.

A relisted signatory will receive a new signature date.

RELISTING SCENARIOS AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Relist having voluntarily delisted for reporting signatories:

- a. Apply to relist at any time during the year.
- b. Accountability:
 - i. statement of compliance with minimum requirements (document)
 - ii. senior leadership statement (document)
- c. Pay the annual fee.
- d. Signatory status accepted.
- e. Full reporting within the next available reporting period (no grace period).

2. Relist having been delisted for failure to report or failure to meet minimum requirements:

- a. Apply to relist.

- b. Complete the next available reporting cycle in the reporting tool, including compliance with the minimum requirements.
- c. Pay the annual fee.
- d. Signatory status accepted.

3. Relisting for non-reporting signatories:

- a. Apply to relist.
 - i. If a service provider, there are no further requirements.
 - ii. If previously held an exemption, then this would need to be reapplied for.
- b. Pay the annual fee.
- c. Signatory status accepted.
